The panel judging applications review on the basis of (i) demonstrated passion for water and the environment, and ambition post graduation, for a wastewater/environmental career, (ii) academic record, (iii) extracurricular activities, iv) Public Service/Volunteerism and, v) Awards, Honors and Leadership positions in organizations.

In general, the panel will look most favorably on applications that demonstrate an overall interest in a career in the wastewater engineering or environmental field. MWEA is investing in students in the hopes of developing future members of WEF who will join our profession and support MWEA and WEF with their talent and time after graduating.
