Directions to Restaurant:

From the north, take Hwy 50 east of I-470 at Unity Village to Hwy 7/150 south. El Puerto will be on your right just after Industrial Drive. From the south, take Hwy 7 north from Harrisonville. El Puerto should be approximately 2.7 mi north of Hwy 58.

Directions to the WWTP:

From El Puerto, head south on 150 Hwy approximately 2.7 miles to Hwy 58 east. Go past the ball field on your right and turn right into the treatment plant.

Description:

The LBVSD Middle Big Creek Treatment Facility has influent pumping, peak flow holding basin, screening and grit removal, activated sludge wastewater treatment plant, tertiary filters and UV disinfection followed by reaeration. The facility sports two aerobic sludge digesters. Sludge is hauled to the LBVSD Atherton WWTP for incineration. Design flow is 2.25 mgd with an average flow of 1.22 mgd. Plans are underway to expand the plant to support development in Lee's Summit.
